

## Cookie and Nut Card Uses

You have worked hard to earn your Cookie Credit and there are lots of ways to use it. The cards can be used in the same way that your paper credit was used. You can check your balance at any time by going to [www.valutec.net](http://www.valutec.net) and entering your card number.

### Using a Cookie/Nut Card as payment for:

- Girl Scouts of Oregon and Southwest Washington Resident Camp Fees  
*When you pay your balance, include the card number on your balance due form.*
- Council Sponsored Events where you register and pay through the council  
*When you register for the event, include the card number on your registration form.*
- Site Registration Fees  
*When you pay your balance, include the card number on your payment form.*
- Girl Scout Dues  
*Include a list of card #'s (last 6 digits) and amount being used for each card*
- Service Unit Sponsored Events  
*Check with your Service Unit Event Coordinator for procedures*
- Girl Scouts of Oregon and Southwest Washington Day Camp Fees  
*Check with your Day Camp Registrar for Camp specific procedures*
- Other Council's Resident Camp or Day Camp Fees  
*Do not send your Cookie Credit cards directly to the other council. Send a copy of your confirmation and the payment information from the other camp along with the Cookie/Nut Card to Girl Scouts of Oregon and Southwest Washington, 9620 SW Barbur Blvd, Portland, OR 97219. Attn. Cookies*
- Girl Scout Store Purchases  
*Bring the physical cookie/nut card to the store for your shopping fun!  
If you cannot come to one of the council stores in person, you may use your cookie credit at our online store by entering it as payment information upon check out. You can also use it to mail order items. You will just need to give your card # along with your purchase information. For a catalog or mail order form, contact your local store or 1-800-338-5248.*

- **Extended Troop Travel**  
*For troops taking approved extended trips, you can use your cookie credits towards your trip. Forms and details are available at [www.girlscoutsosw.org](http://www.girlscoutsosw.org) under Adults > Forms & Publications.*
- **GSUSA destinations Trips**  
*Girls selected for a GSUSA destination event can send their cookie credits along with their statement showing balance due and payment address to Girl Scouts of Oregon and Southwest Washington, 9620 SW Barbur Blvd, Portland, OR 97219. Attn. Cookie.*

When the card has a \$0.00 balance, girls can either keep the cards as a reminder of their hard work, or, they can be sent to your local Girl Scout Service Center to be reloaded for a future Girl Scout's cookie credit! Girl Scouts like to reduce, reuse and recycle!

Lost cards will be assessed a \$3.00 replacement fee. Keep it in a safe place as you would any money.
